

TVYM Deployment Rules and Regulations

The Rules and Regulations for this deployment are altered a little from the normal deployment Rules and Regulations. Although we are Young Marines and will maintain our discipline at all times we will remember that we are in a foreign country. We will learn their history and culture before we deploy as well as while we are deployed. This will be accomplished through our normal training lessons by learning the history and culture of the country we are traveling to. This knowledge we will make us better prepared for this adventure. While out in town we will wear appropriate civilian attire and conduct ourselves as Young Marines. Uniforms will be worn while on Military installations only!!! This will help us to in being less conspicuous in the general public, therefore not creating as much curiosity of the general public as we walk amongst them. Although we are all proud Americans we will subdue our appearance when out in town and not parade the American flag nor slogans while among the general public. We will save that for when we are on the Military bases or formal dinners.

Staff Rules and Regs:

1. All adult staff members must be registered with the National HQ's (**no exceptions**).
2. All Staff members must have the same criteria as the Young Marines with 70% attendance to deploy.
3. All staff members will remember to maintain a professional demeanor at all times.
4. It is the responsibility of Adult Staff Instructors to ensure they prepare themselves for their periods of instruction.
5. Discipline will be handled by the CO; immediate action can be handled by any staff member to ensure the safety of all Young Marines and Staff. Serious infractions will be handled by a Disciplinary Board.
6. All Staff members will share the responsibility of the Officer of the Day billet.
7. At no time will staff members smoke, dip or chew while around the Young Marines.
8. No Staff member will consume or buy Alcoholic beverages at any time while on this deployment.
9. All staff members will remember we are representatives of the United States of America, United States Marine Corps and the Young Marines during this deployment. We will act in a professional manner at all times when utilizing any Military facility or talking to Military personnel.
10. All Young Marine Adult contact shall be handled as prescribed in the National Young Marines Registered Adult Manual.
11. Staff members must remain vigilant at all times and will not wander away from any group while in town or on a Military Installation.
12. At no time will Young Marines be left out of sight from Adult Leaders.
13. Young Marines will not engage in conversation or work with Military personnel unless Adult staff members are present.
14. Every staff member will ensure the Young Marines' Health and Safety comes first as well as their safety and security and that of the Adult Leaders as well.
15. All Adult Staff members must complete the units International Deployment Mentors Course
16. Last, but not least, this will be a stressful deployment and a once in a lifetime opportunity.

Young Marine Rules and Regs:

1. All Young Marines will remain in their racks at night unless standing watch, making a head call or on duty.
2. All Young Marines will stand Fire watch or DNCO and ADNCO.
3. Young Marines will always travel in a minimum Group of four (Fire teams).
4. Every Young Marine is a leader not a follower.
5. Young Marines will take showers every night.
6. Young Marines will not talk to any Military personnel unless accompanied by an Adult staff member or Senior Young Marine.
7. Each Young Marine is responsible for his or her actions.
8. All Young Marines will be prepared the night before for the next day's adventure.
9. All souvenirs must be approved by the Commanding Officer before purchase.
10. All Young Marines will conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times.
11. This is your adventure have fun, take pictures, and write in your deployment logbook.

Senior Young Marine Rules and Regs:

1. All Senior Young Marines must have completed the International Deployment Mentors Course with the Adult Staff.
2. Senior Young Marines will assume the duties of SDNCO.
3. Senior Young Marines will maintain a professional relationship with every Young Marine.
4. Senior Young Marine will ensure they are prepared for their classes.
5. Senior Young Marines are not adults. All final decisions or movements will come from the Adult Staff.
6. Senior Young Marine will remain motivated and dedicated to this deployment and their Young Marines.
7. The Health and Safety of your Young Marines comes first.
8. Senior Young Marines will present themselves as leaders at all times.
9. All Senior Young Marines will immediately forward any issues and/or security breaches to the Adult Staff member assigned to them.
10. Senior Young Marines will prepare their Young Marines and themselves for the next days adventures the night before.
